The Geological Survey of Zimbabwe was established in September 1910 as the Southern Rhodesia Geological Survey following lobbying by the British South Africa Company, the Chamber of Mines and the Rhodesia Museum.

Recruited from the Scottish Office of the British Geological Survey, Herbert Brantwood Maufe became the first and longest serving director of the Southern Rhodesia Geological Survey (1910-1934)

The Department's mandate then was to serve the mining industry by undertaking routine geological mapping, and by offering free advice on geological factors affecting the efficient exploitation of economic minerals, including the determination and analysis of rocks, minerals and ores.

Today, this mandate remains the focus of the activities of the Geological Survey of Zimbabwe.

The symposium will include:
technical sessions over 2 days - 21st - 22nd October 2010 - and
post-symposium **field excursions** of 3 days – 23rd – 25th October, 2010

Details of the excursions, which will focus on the Zimbabwe Craton, will be provided in the second circular.
